

Advent Sunday Class- Advent Sunday Class Begins December 1st - Each Sunday at 11:45am interested parishioners are invited to gather at the Parish Hall/Office Building (in either Fr. Peter's office or the Downstairs Vestry Room) for a one hour course of prayer, conversation, and sharing using Forward Movement's Advent Word of the Day. Calendars with the daily word will become available closer to the beginning of Advent, and interested parishioners (either in the class or for a daily practice) can sign up to receive emails from adventword.org, though all are welcome at our Sunday December classes whether they engage with the daily "word" or not.

<u>Vestry Nominations Open:</u> The election will be held at our Annual Meeting on January 12th, with a half day retreat on January 18th. Our Diocese defines Vestry in this way: *The Mission of the Church is given by God. The Vestry is charged with discerning God's call to this particular congregation and aligning the resources of the church with that call. While Vestry members bring practical skills and thoughtful opinions to the table, their most important role is to be a people of prayer and discernment. Vestry members should be people who are committed to growing in their faith and expanding the congregation's ability to embody love for all God's people.
