Advent Sunday Class- Advent Sunday Class Begins December 1st - Each Sunday at 11:45am interested parishioners are invited to gather at the Parish Hall/Office Building (in either Fr. Peter's office or the Downstairs Vestry Room) for a one hour course of prayer, conversation, and sharing using Forward Movement's Advent Word of the Day. Calendars with the daily word will become available closer to the beginning of Advent, and interested parishioners (either in the class or for a daily practice) can sign up to receive emails from adventword.org, though all are welcome at our Sunday December classes whether they engage with the daily "word" or not.

<u>January 2025 Vestry Election Discernment: What Makes a Good Vestry Member?</u> – At our Annual Meeting on January 12, 2025 we will elect up to three new Vestry members. Vestry service is important and there are both canonical requirements to vestry service, as well as recommended good Episcopal Church practices to follow.

Canonically one must be a "giver of record" (usually done through an annual pledge), who is age 18 and above, not related to a staff member, and either Confirmed or Received into The Episcopal Church (or willing to be during the next opportunity).

Great traits for potential members include being able to work well with others, are regularly seen at worship services and parish events, and are persons with active prayer lives. These qualities help to gather together a Vestry who is able to allow the Holy Spirit to transcend our business discussions and guide us through consensus.

Vestry will take a half day learning retreat on Saturday January 18th to engage with the Holy Spirit for the upcoming year.
