<u>Advent Sunday Class-</u> Advent Sunday Class Begins December 1st - Each Sunday at 11:45am interested parishioners are invited to gather at the Parish Hall/Office Building (in either Fr. Peter's office or the Downstairs Vestry Room) for a one hour course of prayer, conversation, and sharing using Forward Movement's Advent Word of the Day. Calendars with the daily word will become available closer to the beginning of Advent, and interested parishioners (either in the class or for a daily practice) can sign up to receive emails from <u>adventword.org</u>, though all are welcome at our Sunday December classes whether they engage with the daily "word" or not.

Vestry Nominations Open: The election will be held at our Annual Meeting on January 12th, with a half day retreat on January 18th.
